IS IT THE NORTH KOREAN ARMY OR THE COMMUNIST CHINESE ARMY?

The North Korean military parade was held on October 10, 2020 from midnight to 3 a.m. This military parade was very shocking. The North Korean army shown at this military parade is not the North Korean army that we knew. All conventional weapons have changed. Not just simply the ICBMs, but all weapons such as military uniforms, firearms, transport vehicles and tanks have been modernized. In a matter of a year, North Korea has become a whole new army. Changing conventional weapons costs more than developing nuclear weapons. Did North Korea have enough capital to modernize the North Korean army? No. Did China or Russia sell weapons to North Korea violating the UN sanctions against North Korea? No. The North Korean army revealed to us was not the North Korean army. It is most likely an army occupied by the Communist Party of China.

What North Korea has shown is that the Communist Chinese army has entered North Korea. North Korea has been in serious financial trouble due to the sanctions against them. Just two months ago, in August, North Korea partially opened Kim Jong-un's private food reserve and distributed to its people due to a food shortage. In order for North Korea to be heavily armed with new Chinese and Russian weapons, first, North Korea must have hidden capital. Second, there is an issue that China and Russia exported weapons by violating the North Korean sanctions. It's rather farfetched that this was possible under international surveillance. The situation differs greatly if China did not sell weapons to North Korea but if China entered North Korea. Neither did North Korea spend a fortune, nor did China and Russia violate the UN sanctions. China publicly declared its occupation of North Korea in American time.

Was the military parade held from midnight to 3 a.m. simply for the United States to see? Even if the military parade was held at another time, the United States will have seen it. At that time, Pyongyang did not appear in the dark during the military parade. If there had been a battle, such as a war with the Chinese army, the buildings would have definitely been destroyed or damaged. They wouldn't have wanted to show a destroyed or ruined city.

North Korea wanted independence from the Communist Party of China. North Korea's guideline was not to reach out to the Chinese Communist Party even if they had to die of starvation. There were reports that 150,000 Chinese troops were deployed along the border between China and North Korea in April 2017. In June 2020, the U.S. confirmed that North Korea's border was partially opened and that supplies had entered, and in July, Chinese troops were shot to death along the border by North Korean troops, and in August, it was reported that 150 North Korean troops along the border died of the Coronavirus. They say shutting down the city and shooting high-ranking officials was due to preventive measures against the Coronavirus. Reports were coming out as if North Korea was committed to preventive measures and maintained very high vigilance along the Chinese border. There have also been reports of numerous Coronavirus casualties due to a lack of treatment or medical facilities throughout North Korea. Is it true that the North Korean army died of the Coronavirus? At the military parade, no one was wearing a mask or concerned about preventive measures for the Coronavirus. It's skeptical that they are reporting war casualties of the Chinese army and North Korea as coronavirus casualties by taking advantage of this unusual situation of the Coronavirus. Not long ago, North Korea shot and burned a South Korean civil servant when

he crossed the NLL (Northern Limit Line). We can see that the border security stance has become intensified.

China continued to move large number of forces along the Chinese border even after the breakout of the Coronavirus pandemic. They say it's to prevent the spread of the Coronavirus, but it's a military strategy. Like the saying, "look one way and row another," it means to make a loud noise from the west to turn the enemy's eyes while taking care of things from the east. Wouldn't China cause conflict along the Indian border to actually occupy North Korea? Wouldn't the Chinese army have actually invaded North Korea resulting in deaths being reported as Coronavirus casualties? I think it's high possible if it's the Communist Party of China.

You may not agree with this article. However, a convincing explanation should be given to how North Korea was able to change its entire military in a year. North Korea has shown a miracle of having the world's best conventional military within a year.
